






Marshmallow Slime Recipe

Directions




Note: Adult supervision and assistance highly recommended.


The marshmallows will get very HOT in the microwave. Always make sure the materials are cool enough to handle!

STEP 1: Put 6 marshmallows in a microwave safe bowl and pour 1 TBL of oil into the bowl.

STEP 2: Microwave on high for 30 secs. We have a 1200 watt microwave oven so your time may vary slightly.

Fourteen Fun Facts




1. Apples float on water!

Donut Apple Recipe

Ingredients

- Apples
- Spread:
 - Peanut Butter: Crunchy or smooth
 - Almond Butter
 - Jam
- Toppings:
 - Sliced Almonds: Or your preferred nut of choice
 - Sprinkles
 - Mini Chocolate Chips
 - Honey



Directions

Remove the core of the apples. Slice the apples into “donuts.”
Select your spread of choice and smooth about $\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoon of it over one side of the apple donut. Sprinkle your toppings of choice over the “spread.”
